In many countries various organisations and technical tools have been developed to help established writers, and new entrants. These take the form of Literary Associations, Writers Societies, Literary Agents and Agencies, Guidance Bureaus, Translation, Indexing, and Book Review Syndicates, Clipping Bureaus, and a collection of highly useful writers manuals. In India these agencies are now coming into form. This Handbook which contains information about all these agencies and about a number of useful topics of interest is a first step in this direction. As you note from the contents, Handbook is divided into two parts. Part I includes articles on topics of interest to writers and editors. Part II is a reference section, based on information collected through questionnaires from publishers, editors, writers, authors, societies, government agencies, etc. and compiled from the world reference books.
