The Tribe hopes that this liner will be successful and that a large market for bentonite will develop as a result. A bentonite-zeolite-bentonite liner might also be used by industry for fossil fuel refining or for mining waste water treatment. We are currently analyzing the bentonite deposits to determine suitability for use as liner material. Testing includes: defining the Atterberg Limits; determining: Specific Gravity, the Moisture Density Curve and the Toxic Contamination Leak Procedure (inherent contaminants).
